

## Complete Set of Rules for Michigan Forest Products Council Michigan Forests Contest

- Each contestant must “like” MFPC’s Facebook page.
- Each person may submit one photo. The photo must have been taken by the person submitting the photo and not by someone else. The photo must be from a Michigan forest or a forest near the great lakes.
- The picture must celebrate forests in one way or another, whether it’s wildlife in the forest, forests in different seasons, or family members enjoying time spent in the forest.
- To be entered in MFPC’s contest, the photo must be posted on the MFPC Facebook page (<https://www.facebook.com/michiganforest>) and not on personal Facebook profiles or other locations.
- After submitting the photo to MFPC’s Facebook page, contestants may share the photo in a separate Facebook post or to another social media site such as Twitter, however, only the “likes” on the photo itself will be used to count the winner. Likes on the photo’s post, comments, or likes on other social media will not be counted.
- Sharing the post on your timeline is not required but may help you gather additional likes on the photo.
- MFPC will determine the winner by looking at the total number of likes on each photo, and the photo with the most likes will win the prize.
- MFPC will shut down the contest on Monday March 7<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 PM Eastern time and declare the winner shortly thereafter. No “likes” after this time will be counted.
- By entering this contest, participants agree to release their photo; MFPC is not responsible for the protection of the photo from being used by others in the future. This contest is not sponsored by Facebook or another party.
